The Milk Jug Collects a Record \$155K for Local Charities

HOBE SOUND, Fla. – The Milk Jug, an annual fundraising affair hosted by professional golfer Nick Price, local businessman David Abell, and Peter Lund, the president of McArthur Golf Club in Hobe Sound, Fla., announced they raised over \$155,000 during their last affair at McArthur Golf Club on December 17.

Along with Nick Price, a few of the celebrities contributing to The Milk Jug this year were baseball pitcher Jim Kaat, professional golfer Brett Quigley, and USGA Senior Amateur Champion Vinny Giles.

The Milk Jug was formed in 2004 amongst 48 individuals who had a common goal to raise funds for Palm Beach and Martin County charities whose mandate, services or programs focused on improving the lives and welfare of children within the community. Since its inception, The Milk Jug has distributed over \$493,000 to over 32 charities throughout the region.
